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Adam Lampton is a photographer currently residing in South Portland, Maine. In addition to exhibiting internationally, Adam's work has been seen in publications including Art in America, Maisonneuve Magazine, and Polar Inertia Journal. He is a recipient of a 2006-07 William J. Fulbright fellowship to Macao, SAR, China and a finalist for a 2007 Massachusetts Cultural Council Artist Grant. LamptonÖs photographs explore spaces in transition. Past bodies of work have ranged from interiors of familiar places to ex-urban shantytowns. His photographs challenge our sense of permanence and stability in a world of constant transformation. Whether it is internal, external, physical or metaphorical this unending process can at once cause anxiety or be a comfort, depending on perspective. Lampton uses the camera to negotiate this process and record his own response to the particularities of a space.

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
